Studying at NGI as an International Student

International students are eligible for our full-time Chef's Training Program with an M-1 vocational school student visa. If you have any other current visa status please be sure to let us know right away as we will need to have this information to properly issue your I-20. Steps for obtaining a visa to study at NGI include:

- 1. <u>Apply for the Chef's Training Program</u>*. As an international student, the following documents must be submitted online with your application:
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - Proof of graduation from high school a diploma or transcript from high school or college
 - A resume or CV
 - A headshot
 - Short essay answers
 - Copy of your passport
 - Bank letter certifying that you have access to at least \$36,000 US Dollars.
 - TOEFL Scores of 85+ or intermediate levels in all categories

2. Pay the \$9,000 down payment due two weeks after acceptance, in order to enroll in the program and reserve your place in the class. Admissions will then issue you an I-20** (<u>learn more about the I-20</u>) and mail you a hard copy to arrive within about 2-5 business days.

**If you have any other current visa status please be sure to let us know right away as we will need to have this information to properly issue your I-20.

- 3. Pay the I-901 SEVIS fee and schedule your visa interview with your local US consulate.
- 4. Carefully read this <u>Study in the States Guide</u> to understand the visa process and documents needed to obtain your visa.
